Women worldwide have been celebrating International Women's Day on March 8th since 1975, to reflect on progress made to achieve gender equality, to celebrate acts of courage and determination by ordinary women who have played an extraordinary role in the history of their countries and communities and to call for sustainable change.

The adoption of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, including the Sustainable Development Goals, has made 2015 without a doubt one of the most important years for gender equality and will transform our world by 2030. At this moment, 90 world leaders have already made concrete commitments and firm pledges to overcome gender equality gaps.

Since our foundation in 1919, Zonta has worked tirelessly locally and internationally to serve our communities, advocated for women's rights to be recognized and respected as human rights, and contributed to sustainable change and to a life with dignity and free of violence for all women and girls.

Equal rights and a life free of violence is NOT a women's issue; it is a societal issue that has to be solved by women and men together.
