Zonta International is encouraging every member to donate to the Zonta International Foundation.

The Zonta International Foundation is happy to work with clubs and districts to accept group gifts. Clubs, areas or districts may collect individual gifts and consolidate into one payment.

Gifts of at least US\$500 may be applied to multiple funds. Gifts may be attributed to multiple donors, with a minimum of US\$25.00 per donor.

### 2017 North American Inter-District Meeting

A number of Zontians from District 7 attended the North American Inter-District Meeting in McLean, Virginia, June 2-4. Many were able to take the opportunity to go one day early and learn about first hand advocacy by meeting with Senate representatives from our home state. All the meetings were coordinated in advance and were preceded by a brief presentation on how to advocate for the removal of the deadline for ERA ratification and the Campus Accountability and Safety Act which remains stalled in committee.

Thank you to all who attended the District 7 Conference in Minneapolis! It was a wonderful weekend reconnecting with so many friends in our District. It was a delightful experience getting to know Ursula Werner, Zonta International Director.

As we enter into the second year of the biennium I would like to share with you a message we received from the Zonta Leadership e-newsletter.... As a result of your efforts, we have seen a positive impact of the <u>Global Membership Drive</u> campaign. In first year of the biennium, Zonta welcomed 2,532 new members, which included 131 first time Young Professional Members. But our 2016-2018 goals are much more ambitious seeking out a net membership growth of 5% across all districts. If you remain visible and relevant in your communities then we know you will be able to attract and retain committed members. Who have you invited to be a Zontian so far this year?

It is up to us the members to share the good news about Zonta and welcome new members to each one of our clubs in District 7.
