

### Prevention Continuum





Before violence or behavior occurs; work on changing attitudes and norms that support it

### SECONDARY

Intervene to prevent violence from happening again; deal with short-term consequences


#### **TERTIARY**

Treat after
violence occurs;
support victims
to heal; provide
treatment to
offenders

Primary prevention does not replace intervention, it compliments it.

Violence

- Teaching healthy, safe dating and intimate relationship skills to teens
- Promoting healthy sexuality
- Empowermentbased training



STOP

- Strengthening economic supports for women and families
- Strengthening leadership and opportunities for girls



- Improving safety and monitoring in schools
- Establishing and consistently applying workplace policies
- Addressing community-level risks through environmental approaches



- Victim-centered services
- Treatment for victims of SV
- Treatment for at-risk children and families to prevent problem behavior including sex offending



# THE GREEN DOT METAPHOR








